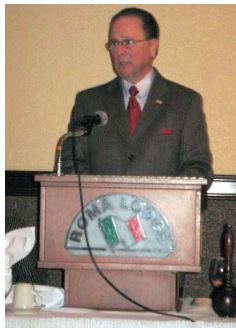

March 24, 2009 Declared ROMA LODGE DAY in Racine County!!

William McReynolds, County Executive for Racine County informed Roma Lodge that the Racine County Board voted to recognize and honor Roma Lodge for its sponsorship of the annual Racine County Foster Care Christmas Party for the past ten years. The proclamation was presented to Tom Garbo, who chairs the event, and to Roma Lodge President, Buddy Alfano. Other Board members also attended the event. When asked by the County Board why Roma Lodge has sponsored this event over the years, Tom Garbo issued this statement:

At the turn of the Century, and even before that, there was a tremendous influx of immigrants that arrived at Ellis Island in New York City. With them came all their dreams and aspirations of a new and prosperous life. They knew there were going to be trials and tribulations, but with hard work, they could succeed to great heights. The Italian immigrants were no different. On the plaque on the Statute of Liberty, there is a slogan on the lady which reads, "Give me your tired and your poor, your huddled masses yearning to breathe free, the wretched of your teeming shore, send these, the homeless, tempest tossed to me: I life my lamp beside the golden door." Reading that slowly and understanding what it means is the reason that Roma Lodge does what is does in the community, without fanfare or recognition. It is our members' belief that we have been blessed with much support from the local communities and we want to help in any way we can. And one of the ways is to host the Foster Kids Christmas Party. To see the eyes of the children open wide as they receive a present from Santa Claus because some care is both tear jerking and awe inspiring. For Roma Lodge to be a part of that is the best understanding of what that famous statue plaque is all about.

WHEREAS, Roma Lodge is always very accommodating and has never asked for recognition for what it does every year for the foster children and their families;



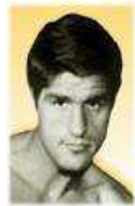

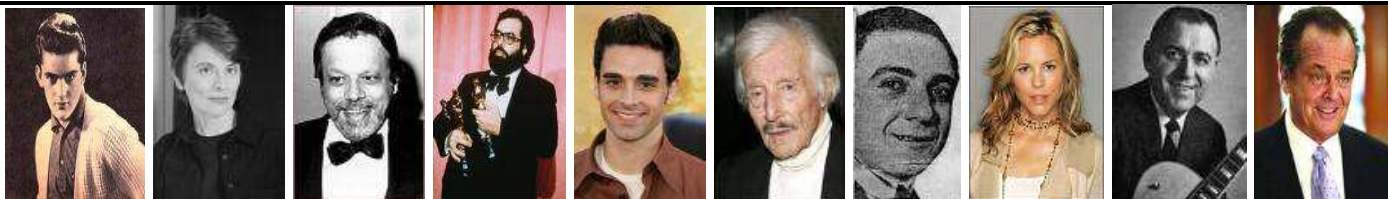

ITALIAN EASTER TRADITIONS - UOVO DI PASQUA

Although Italians do not decorate hard-boiled eggs nor have chocolate bunnies or pastel marshmallow chick, the biggest Easter displays in bars, pastry shops, supermarkets, and especially at chocolatiers are brightly wrapped uova di Pasqua - chocolate Easter eggs - in sizes that range from 10 grams (1/3 ounce) to 8 kilos (nearly 18 pounds). Most of them are made of milk chocolate in a mid-range 10 ounce size by industrial chocolate makers.



Some producers distinguish between their chocolate eggs for children and expensive "adult versions". All except the tiniest eggs contain a surprise. Grown-ups often find their eggs contain little silver picture frames to gold-dipped costume jewelry. The very best eggs are handmade by artisan of chocolate, who offer the service of inserting a surprise supplied by the purchaser. Car keys, engagement rings, and watches are some of the high-end gifts that have been tucked into Italian chocolate eggs in Italy.
